08.332-Motion by Duncklee and second by Burke to approve Federal Functional Classification Changes Resolution. Motion carried.

**RESOLUTION NO. 08.332
FEDERAL FUNCTIONAL CLASSIFICATION CHANGES**

WHEREAS, functional classification is the process by which streets and highways are grouped into classes according to the character of service they are intended to provide; and

WHEREAS, Allamakee County Board of Supervisors periodically reviews the system of streets and highways for appropriate changes to classification of the various segments of the system; and

WHEREAS, a recent review of the system has revealed the need for a change to the federal functional classification of road segments due to road and bridge alignments.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Allamakee County Board of Supervisors hereby requests the Iowa Department of Transportation to request the Federal Highway Administration to make the following changes in federal functional classification:

The portion of roadway to be changed from Major Collector to Local is located in French Creek Twp. Section 2 and Union City Twp. Sections 34 and 35. Beginning at the intersection of Hartley Drive and Lycurgus Road in Section 2, French Creek Twp. running northwesterly on Hartley Drive and terminating at the intersection of Hartley Drive and Iowa River Drive(Route A-26), Union City Twp. Section 34. The total length of change is 1.093 miles. From the intersection of Lycurgus Road and Hartley Drive northwesterly 0.704 miles will have the Local status, the other 0.389 miles located north of the Upper Iowa River in Section 34, Union City Twp. was vacated by Resolution No. 06.221 on 06/26/06.

The portion of roadway to be changed from Local to Major Collector is located in French Creek Twp. Section 2 and Union City Twp. Section 35. Beginning at the intersection of Hartley Drive and Lycurgus Road in Section 2 French Creek Twp. running northeasterly on Lycurgus Road terminating at the intersection with Iowa River Drive(Route A-26) Union City Twp. Section 35. The total length of the change is 0.524 miles.

Union City Twp. is T100N-R5W and French Creek Twp. is T99N-R5W.

The Board of Supervisors of Allamakee County in lawful session this 13th day of October, 2008 hereby adopts this Federal Functional Classification change resolution.
