

**THE MINUTES OF THE ALLAMAKEE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
MONDAY, OCTOBER 19, 2009**

Board met as preadjourned. Board members present Kuhse, Campbell, and Burke. All Board members voting "AYE" unless noted.

09.310-Motion by Kuhse and second by Campbell to approve agenda and minutes of October 12, 2009. Motion carried.

Tom Blake, Frank Gaines, Mary Jane White, and Jeanie Carroll present.

Due to an error in publication the meeting tonight, October 19th, will be a work session instead of a public hearing for the Zoning Ordinance & Subdivision Regulations Amendments. A new date & time needs to be set for the public hearing, but will wait until the Planning & Zoning Commission has their meeting at 4:30 and sets their new date & time and will then set at the work session.

09.311-Motion by Campbell and second by Kuhse to approve & sign the Hacker, Nelson & Co Agreement of Audit. Motion carried.

09.312-Motion by Campbell and second by Kuhse to approve Sheriff's Quarterly Report. Motion carried.

09.313-Motion by Campbell and second by Kuhse to approve Wings Liquor License. Motion carried. Burke abstained.

Brian Ridenour present.

Ridenour gave an update on projects.

Under other matters, Frank Gaines had questions about the Zoning Ordinance access issues and wondering why we are following the 911 Ordinance if they don't have the authority to zone.

Board reconvened at 6:00 p.m. for a work session. Board members present Kuhse, Campbell, and Burke.

Many members from the public and courthouse were present.

09.314-Motion by Kuhse and second by Campbell to set the Zoning Ordinance & Subdivision Regulations Amendments public hearing for Monday, October 26th @ 6:00 pm. Motion carried.

There have been comments about what is actually being amended in the proposed ordinance text. Blake and White will get together and highlight the areas that are included in the amendments so will be easier to track back to the original Ordinance.

Individuals of the public spoke to the Board about their concerns with the three acre minimum lot size, bluffland protection, access issues, and the "grandfather" clause. The Board thanked everyone for their input and we take all into consideration in the future.
