

**MINUTES OF THE MEETINGS OF THE ALLAMAKEE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
MONDAY, MARCH 16, 2009**

Board met as preadjourned. Board members present Kuhse and Burke. Campbell was absent. All board members voting "AYE" unless noted.

09.097-Motion by Kuhse and second by Burke to approve agenda and minutes of March 9, 2009. Motion carried.

During public comment time Kuhse gave an update on the pioneer cemeteries that had been discussed at the Mar. 2nd meeting. He's still waiting to hear back from Jane Regan about liability issues.

Leon Schoh and Ron Roese present.

Ron Roese wanted to give the Board a heads up on his upcoming plans of retirement. Kuhse asked some questions as to how the fees are set and the revenue we receive from them. Roese will get some figures together for each of the counties.

Chris Gavin present.

Leon Schoh had concerns about the English Bench Watershed and the funds available for future maintenance on the sites. Burke will check with LuAnn Rollings at Soil & Water Conservation to discuss the funding of this.

09.098-Motion by Kuhse and second by Burke to sign the Iowa DHS community Mental Health Center Affiliation for Northeast Iowa Behavioral Health. Motion carried.

Mike Gallagher present.

Mike Gallagher discussed the problem with cigarette butts outside since they took the smoking post down last summer and inquired about putting them back up. Board told Gallagher to put one at the end of each sidewalk for public use. Also held discussion about parking in the north lot and will designate the first row for customer use and ask the employees not to park there.

RESOLUTION 09.099 – ROAD EMBARGO

WHEREAS, weather conditions will soon cause some of the secondary roads in Allamakee County to deteriorate to an extent that heavy loads will cause considerable damage, and WHEREAS, it will be necessary to reduce and restrict the gross axle weights of vehicles using certain secondary roads in Allamakee County, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that signs setting forth this restriction be posted at both ends and at the approaches of intersecting roads for each and every secondary road for which the restriction is deemed necessary. This resolution is to be effective upon posting of the signs and is to be in accordance with Section 321, Code of Iowa 2007. Dated at Waukon, Iowa this 16th day of March, 2009.
